1. **Reserve at East Bay Golf Course**  
On East Bay Boulevard, (801) 373-6262
2. **Provo Towne Centre**  
Just west of University Avenue in South Provo near I-15 exit #263
3. **Provo City Airport**  
West on Center Street to 3100 West. Look for signs. Uncontrolled, lighted runways FBO's, ILS, and weather service. No major airlines. (801) 852-6715
4. **Utah Lake State Park**  
West end of Center Street. Boating, water skiing, fishing, and day camping. Entry fee required. (801) 375-0731
5. **Lakeside Campground**  
4000 West Center Street, (801) 373-5267
6. **Fort Utah Park**  
Located at 2050 West 200 North, where Provo began in 1849.
7. **KOA Campground**  
320 North 2050 West, (801) 375-2994
8. **Historic Downtown Provo**  
Free parking, large variety of shops, restaurants, and places of entertainment.
9. **Seven Peaks Water Park**  
1330 East 300 North, Provo. The state's largest water park. (801) 373-8777
10. **The Peaks Ice Arena**  
100 North Seven Peaks, Provo. A 2002 winter Olympic venue that provides ice hockey, ice skating and indoor soccer. (801) 377-8777
11. **BYU Museum of People and Cultures**  
700 North 100 East, Provo. (801) 422-0020
12. **North Park**  
500 North 500 West. Open summer months. Free admission. Pioneer museum. Swimming pool and park.
13. **Utah Valley Regional Medical Center**  
1034 North 500 West, (801) 373-7850
14. **Provo Recreation Center and Pool**  
1155 North University Avenue on Provo High School campus. Open Mon-Sat year-round. Indoor pool, weight room, handball. Fee required. (801) 852-6610
15. **Brigham Young University**  
Go east on 1230 North from University Avenue. Home of the BYU Cougars. Call (801) 378-INFO for general information. Call hosting center for tours (801) 422-4678.
16. **Marriott Center**  
University Parkway. Home of BYU Cougar basketball. Ticket office (801) 378-BYU1.
17. **Monte L. Bean Life Science Museum**  
Just east of Marriott Center. Fascinating close-up views of nature through mounted animal, bird, shell and insect collections from around the world. Free admission. Open Tues-Sat 10 A.M. to 5 P.M. (801) 422-5051
18. **BYU Conference Center**  
360-seating auditorium; 560-seat assembly room; executive conference room. (801) 422-7700
19. **LaVell Edwards Stadium**  
1700 North Canyon Road. Seats 66,000 for BYU football in one of America's most beautiful stadium settings.
20. **Missionary Training Center**  
2005 North 900 East. Accommodates 3,000 LDS missionaries for training before departure to missions around the world. (801) 422-2602
21. **Provo Mormon (LDS) Temple**  
2200 North Temple Hill Drive (801) 375-5775
22. **BYU Museum of Art**  
Located on Campus Drive, this museum features world-class art exhibits. Call (801) 378-2787 for more information.
23. **BYU Earth Science Museum**  
Directly west of LaVell Edwards Stadium. Features dinosaur fossils, skeletons. (801) 422-3680
24. **University Mall**  
Over 165 stores and restaurants. On University Parkway between State Street and 800 East in Orem.
25. **Utah Valley State College**  
Rapidly growing college welcomes visitors. Located at 800 West just north of the University Parkway in Orem. (801) 863-INFO.
26. **Scera**  
699 South State Street. Offers concerts, Broadway musicals, and other productions under the stars at the Shell. Offers a movie theater and a museum. (801) 225-2569
27. **The Shops at Riverwoods**  
Charming shopping district with shops, restaurants and adjacent 12-screen movie complex. Just off University Ave. in Provo at eastern extension of Orem's Center Street.
28. **Trafalga Family Fun Center**  
168 South 1200 West (just off Orem Center Street I-15 exit) Large arcade, miniature golf and more. (801) 224-6000
29. **Orem Fitness Center**  
165 South 580 West, Orem. Olympic-sized swimming pool, indoor track, racquetball, basketball. (801) 229-7155
30. **Cascade Golf Center and Miniature Golf**  
1313 East 800 North in Orem. 18-holes, closed Sundays. (801) 225-6677
31. **Bridal Veil Falls**  
Breathtaking double-cataract waterfall just minutes up Provo Canyon on Hwy 189.
32. **Vivian Park and Heber Valley Historic Railroad**  
3630 E. Provo Canyon Road. Picnic and volleyball facilities. (801) 851-8600. Call (435) 654-5601 for train rides/information.
33. **Sundance Resort**  
Nine miles from mouth of Provo Canyon on Hwy 92. Year-round resort includes skiing, hiking, restaurants, and summer programs. (801) 225-4107
34. **Mt. Timpanogos**  
Majestic peak rises 11,957 feet above sea level. Most popular trail to the summit leads from Aspen Grove 5 miles past a series of waterfalls, lakes, and the Timpanogos Glacier.
35. **Timpanogos Cave National Monument**  
Explore haunting beauty of natural limestone caverns. Open approximately mid May to mid October. Visitors Center hours 7 A.M. to 5:30 P.M. daily. Access from State Hwy 92. (801) 756-5238 or (801) 756-5239.
36. **Timpanogos Regional Hospital**  
750 West 800 North, Orem. (801) 714-6000
37. **Tri-City Golf Course**  
1400 North 200 East, American Fork. (801) 756-3594
38. **Thanksgiving Point**  
Acres of gardens, golf, shops, animals, and family fun. Just west of I-15 near exit #284. (801) 768-2300
39. **Camp Floyd/Stagecoach Inn**  
25 miles southwest of Lehi on State Road 73. Old military post and historic overnight stop on Overland Stage and Pony express route. (801) 768-8932
40. **Uinta National Forest**  
Much of Utah county's eastern area is prime recreation territory in thousands of acres of Uinta National Forest.
41. **Springville Museum of Art**  
126 East 400 South, Springville. Spanish colonial revival-style building houses room after room of art treasures. Closed Mondays and holidays. Admission free; donations appreciated. (801) 489-2727
42. **Hobble Creek Golf Course**  
Hobble Creek Canyon road, east of Springville. (801) 489-6297
43. **Spanish Oaks Golf Course**  
2300 Powerhouse Road, Spanish Fork. Just south of Hwy 6 near junction Hwy 89. (801) 798-9816

**Alpine Loop Scenic Backway**  
Follows State Hwy 92 for 17 miles around the 11,750-foot Mt. Timpanogos. (Accessible from Provo or American Fork Canyons.) A \$3 fee is required for use of facilities. No fee for drive through traffic. Closed for winter.

**Nebo Loop Scenic Byway**  
Travels 32 miles through the Uinta National forest between Payson and Nephi. (Also accessible from Santaquin.) Closed for winter.
